**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DATES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PROPOSED EQUALIZED VALUATIONS AND FOR APPEALS THEREFROM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10A of chapter 58 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 283 of the acts of  
3 1979, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — On or  
5 before June twentieth in each year in which an equalization is to be  
6 established, the commissioner shall hold a public hearing on the  
7 proposed equalized valuations.

1 SECTION 2. Section 10B of said chapter 58, as most recently  
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 283 of the acts of 1979, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence: — On or before August  
5 twentieth next following, a city or town aggrieved by the equalized  
6 valuation established for it by the commissioner under sections  
7 nine and ten A may appeal the determination of the commissioner  
8 to the appellate tax board.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to equalized  
2 valuations required to be established on or after January first,  
3 nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
