AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECIPROCITY OF LICENSING FOR NURSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 76B, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, the
- 3 following section: —
- 4 Section 76C. The Board may register or license without re-
- 5 examination any person who has taken and passed the Canadian
- 6 Nursing Board Examination and has by reciprocity or other legal
- 7 means been granted licensure in a state with reciprocity
- 8 agreements with Massachusetts. The person must have a current
- 9 license in said state and be able to provide at least two
- 10 endorsements from qualified employers and/or officials licensed
- 11 in that state.
