R E S O L V E

Making an appropriation to meet deficiencies in former Appropriations for the support of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars, be and the same hereby is, appropriated from the current revenue of the Commonwealth, for the use of the trustees of the State Reform School at Westborough, to pay deficiencies in the appropriations for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-nine and eighteen hundred and sixty.
