AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMISSIONER OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT TO ALLOW FOR A RESERVATION PROCEDURE OF CAMPSITES AT STATE PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2D of Chapter 132A, as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 706 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by
3 adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—

4 The Commissioner shall provide a procedure by which half of all
5 the campsites within the state parks, state forest recreation areas,
6 and state reservations may be reserved by individuals one week in
7 advance. The remainder of campsites shall be available to individu-
8 als upon registration.
