

HOUSE No. 4455

By Mr. Brett of Quincy, petition of Joseph E. Brett relative to amount of pension payable to certain veterans. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO AMOUNT OF PENSION PAYABLE TO CERTAIN VETERANS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to restore pension benefits to certain
3 veterans, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
4 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
5 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 700 of the acts of 1968, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following sentence: —
4 In addition to the amount of any pension payable under the
5 provisions of this section, such veteran shall receive any cost of
6 living increases provided for under any provisions of law.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to
2 October seventeenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Chapter 269A, Section 27 - Unlawful Use of Funds

SECTION 27. UNLAWFUL USE OF FUNDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1. Whoever The official character of the act would tend to
2. defame the person, which is to require person benefit in course
3. of business, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
4. law necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
5. health, safety or interest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the State, as follows:

1. Section 1. Section 26 of chapter 269 of the General Laws, as
2. now amended, amended by chapter 700 of the acts of 1982, is
3. hereby further amended by adding the following section:
4. In addition to the amount of any person payable under any
5. provision of this section, such person shall receive any sum of
6. living income provided for under any provision of law.

1. Section 2. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to
2. October seventh, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
