## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

### AN ACT

Relating to the Registration of Chiropodists.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hun-  
2 dred and two of the General Acts of nineteen  
3 dred and seventeen is hereby amended by striking  
4 out the words "October in the year nineteen  
5 hundred and seventeen", in the first and second  
6 lines, and substituting the words:— March, in  
7 the year nineteen hundred and eighteen, — so as  
8 to read as follows:— *Section 2.* On and after the  
9 first day of March, in the year nineteen hundred  
10 and eighteen, it shall be unlawful for any person  
11 to practise or attempt to practise chiropody in  
12 this commonwealth, or to hold himself out as a

13 chiropodist, or to designate himself, or describe  
14 his occupation, by the use of any words or letters  
15 calculated to lead others to believe that he is a  
16 registered chiropodist, unless he is duly registered  
17 as provided in this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
