AN ACT PERTAINING TO C.P.R. CERTIFICATION FOR ALL STATE EMPLOYEES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 125 as appearing in the 1986 Official
2 Edition is hereby amended by inserting after Section 4 the
3 following new section:

4 Section 4A. All state employees in the department of
5 correction shall be certified in C.P.R., within one year of being
6 employed, and recertified each ensuing year of employment.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 123 shall be hereby
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph 2:

3 In addition to adherence to the provisions for psychiatric
4 treatment all employees of the Department of Mental Health shall
5 be certified in C.P.R., within one year of being employed and
6 recertified each ensuing year of employment.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 111 is hereby amended by inserting after
2 Section 2C the following new section:

3 Section 2D. All state employees of the Department of Public
4 Health shall be certified in C.P.R. within one year of being
5 employed and recertified each ensuing year of employment.
