### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A STENOGRAPHER IN TRIALS OF MISDEMEANORS IN THE SUPERIOR COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33A of chapter 278 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 In any proceeding or trial in the superior court upon a  
4 complaint for a misdemeanor, upon motion of any party  
5 allowed by the court, or by order of the court the evidence  
6 shall be taken by an official stenographer or by a stenog-  
7 rapher appointed by the court.
