AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF THE REAL ESTATE REVIEW BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 693 of the acts of 1955, as amended by
- 2 chapter 657 of the acts of 1957, is hereby further amended by
- 3 adding the following paragraph:—
- 4 All expenses and payments incurred by the real estate
- 5 review board in their determination shall be paid mutually,
- 6 in equal parts, by the parties in interest.
