AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF AN ASSISTANT CLERK FOR EQUITY PROCEEDINGS IN THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 6D the following section: —

3 *Section 6E.* The justices of the Superior Court may desig-
4 nate, for a term of three years from the date of such desig-
5 nation, one of the assistant clerks for the county of Plymouth,
6 appointed under section four, to perform under the direction
7 of the clerk of courts for the county of Plymouth, the duties
8 of clerk pertaining to the equity proceedings of said court, who
9 shall receive from said county, in addition to the salary paid to
10 him as an assistant clerk under section four, a sum equivalent
11 to five per cent of the salary of the clerk.
