DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether AAFR, Inc. d.b.a. Academica Club violated 204 CMR 2.05(2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age.

The licensee stipulated to the facts contained in the investigator's report dated May 14, 2008.

The report states an underage operative, d.o.b. 11/24/90 (age17) purchased a Heineken Beer for \$2.75 at the Academica Club. The young woman was not asked for identification by the server.

Administrative review of the file indicates this was the first A.B.C.C. violation by the licensee in 40 years of existence.

The Commission finds the licensee violated Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age and, therefore, **issues a warning.**
