AN ACT RELATIVE TO A VETERANS CONGREGATE HOUSING FACILITY IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 adding after the last paragraph the following: —

4 He shall coordinate the preparation of plans and the
5 construction or renovation of a veterans congregate housing
6 facility in the city of Worcester, including the cost of furnishings,
7 equipment, and ancillary services.

1 SECTION 2. The commissioner of veterans' services shall
2 conduct a study to investigate ways of financing a congregate
3 housing facility in the city of Worcester including, but not limited
4 to, industrial revenue bonds, funding under the provisions of
5 chapter six hundred and sixty-seven or chapter one hundred and
6 eighteen E, federal financial assistance, and private contributions.
7 The commissioner shall report the results of his study, together
8 with legislative recommendations, if any, to the clerks of the
9 House and Senate and to the Joint Committee on Human Services
10 and Elderly Affairs on or before the tenth of July, nineteen
11 hundred and ninety.
