

HOUSE No. 178

Accompanying the petition of William N. Cronin and others that the town of Kingston be authorized to acquire ground sources of water supply and that certain action of said town in acquiring land and driving artesian wells be ratified. Water Supply.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act ratifying Certain Action of Town of Kingston in acquiring Land and driving Artesian Wells thereon and authorizing Said Town to acquire Ground Sources of Water Supply.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred
2 and thirty-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-five is hereby amended by inserting the
4 words:—or of any ground sources of supply by
5 means of driven, artesian or other wells,—after the
6 words “pond, stream or spring” in the third line
7 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. The acquiring of certain lands by the
2 town of Kingston and the taking of water by means
3 of driven, artesian or other wells is hereby validated

4 and confirmed and said acts are made valid to the
 5 same effect as if done under the authority of this
 6 act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
 2 passage.
