By Messrs. Otis of Boston and O'Loughlin of Boston, petition of William F. Otis, Joseph M. O'Loughlin and James C. Bayley for legislation to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles in the downtown area of the city of Boston between certain hours. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

### AN ACT PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized and di-  
2 rected to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles in the downtown  
3 area of the city of Boston between the hours of eight o'clock  
4 antemeridian and five o'clock postmeridian, with the exception  
5 of taxicabs and trucks making delivery to mercantile establish-  
6 ments within the city. The area to which this act shall apply  
7 shall be determined by the planning board of the city of Boston  
8 and the traffic commissioner of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance  
2 by vote of the city council of the city of Boston approved by  
3 the mayor of said city and the filing of a certificate of such ac-  
4 ceptance with the state secretary, but not otherwise.
