**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REORGANIZATION OF THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32A, Section 3, shall be amended by deleting the text  
2 following the words, "to be known as the Group Insurance  
3 Commission", and before the words, "The Commission shall be  
4 provided with suitable," and inserting in its place the following:  
5 "Consisting of a designee appointed by the Massachusetts Retired  
6 State, County, and Municipal Employees Association, a designee  
7 of the Commission of Administration and Finance, a designee of  
8 the Commissioner of Insurance, and five appointees designated by  
9 the Governor. The Senate president and the speaker of the House  
10 of Representatives shall each appoint three designees, one of  
11 whom shall be a member of the minority party. Additionally, each  
12 bargaining unit comprised of state employees, as certified by the  
13 Massachusetts Labor Relations Commission, shall appoint a  
14 designee."
