*To the Honorable Members of the Great and General Court of the Commonwealth of  
Massachusetts.*

Under the provisions of chapter 101 of the Resolves of 1961, the department was directed to continue a study of the recreational needs of Adams. A further field survey was made as a result of the resolve, and department representatives reviewed the previous reports and development plans. No funds were appropriated to carry out the provisions of the resolve.

The department finds no reason to amend the original report relating to this study. The most recent survey indicates encroachment upon the general area surrounding the proposed recreational site in the form of housing development. Further, very recently there are indications that the site itself, "Thiel Farm", as well as a major portion of other land in the area, under the jurisdiction of the Greylock Reservation Commission, has been leased to another quasi-public agency of the Commonwealth.
