AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ASSISTANT CLERK
IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE ROXBURY DISTRICT COURT IN
CHARGE OF THE CIVIL SESSIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 6 of chapter 796 of the acts of
3 1973, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 paragraph: —

5 In the municipal court of the Roxbury district, the clerk may
6 designate one of his assistant clerks as assistant clerk in charge of
7 the civil sessions. The salary of said assistant clerk shall be equal
8 to eighty-seven and one half per cent of the maximum salary of
9 the clerk of said court.
