## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Four.

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO NOTIFY MUNICIPALITIES WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENALTIES OR ILLEGAL DUMPING OF HAZARDOUS WASTES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 21C of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The attorney general of the commonwealth shall notify each city
- 4 and town executive officer and board of health officer, of the
- 5 penalties for illegal disposition of hazardous waste, by promulgat-
- 6 ing said penalties on a yearly basis to said city and town officials.
