### AN ACT

To provide for the better Enforcement of the Law requiring Specifications to be furnished to Weavers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The governor shall appoint an additional  
2 member of the district police force, who shall receive  
3 the same compensation as other members of the force,  
4 and who shall be specially charged with the enforcement  
5 of chapter five hundred and thirty-four of the acts of  
6 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled "an  
7 act requiring specifications to be furnished to persons  
8 employed in cotton factories."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
