The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION PLANS TO BE FILED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority
3 shall prepare a service plan providing for: (a) increased bus service
4 on Route 57, so-called, and reserving street cars at Kenmore
5 station for the use of passengers alighting from Route 57 buses;
6 (b) a specific date for the transfer of street car repair service from
7 the Watertown car yard; and (c) a specific date for the removal
8 of the existing street car track from Brighton avenue to Water-
9 town square and the reconstruction of said streets, said date to
10 be no later than one year from the date street car repair service
11 is removed from the Watertown car yard.

12 Said plan shall be filed with the clerk of the house of repre-
13 sentatives on or before September fifteenth, nineteen hundred and
14 ninety.
