## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS HISTORICAL COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 26 of Chapter 9 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after the second sentence the following: —

3 The State Secretary may appoint no more than five additional  
4 persons to the commission. Any person so appointed shall be  
5 qualified in one of the following: — history; archeology; architec-  
6 ture; architectural history; or closely related discipline.
