AN ACT

To legalize and confirm Certain Proceedings of the Town of Plainfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The action of the town of Plainfield
2 relative to the appropriation of money for telephone ser-
3 vice, taken at the annual meeting of said town, held on
4 the second day of March in the year eighteen hundred
5 and ninety-six, is hereby legalized and confirmed, but
6 nothing herein contained shall authorize or empower said
7 town to construct or maintain a telephone line.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
