### RESOLVE

Relative to reclaiming and improving Waste and Unused Land with the Labor of Prisoners from Jails and Houses of Correction.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding  
3 twenty-five thousand dollars, to be expended under the  
4 direction of the governor and council in carrying out the  
5 provisions of chapter three hundred and ninety-three of  
6 the acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, relative  
7 to reclaiming and improving waste and unused land with  
8 the labor of prisoners from jails and houses of correction.
