In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five.

AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Second Clerk in the Office of
the Chief of the District Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the second clerk in the
2 office of the chief of the district police shall be fourteen
3 hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed from the first of
4 January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
