AN ACT REPEALING THE BAN ON SUNDAY HUNTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 57 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 repealed.

By the bill the same Senate for the purpose of holding a public hearing on the bill should be held on the 10th day of January, A. D. 1907, at the time and place specified in the bill as to the hearing. A. D. 1907.
