DECISION

A LIFE STORY INC. D/B/A BEACON HILL WINE & GOURMET
532-546 MAIN ST., UNIT 1

A Life Story Inc. d/b/a Beacon Hill Wine & Gourmet (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 13, 2016; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
 - A. Licensee's Written Explanation dated May 14, 2016.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

1. On Friday, May 13, 2016, at approximately 8:14 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Keefe investigated the business operation of A Life Story Inc. d/b/a Beacon Hill Wine & Gourmet.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Budweiser Light beer for six dollars and ninety-five cents (\$6.95). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for many years with no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
