RESOLVE

Providing for certain Repairs and Improvements at the State Normal School at Bridgewater.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 twelve thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight dollars,
4 to be expended at the State Normal School at Bridge-
5 water, for the following purposes : —

6 For tinting and painting the interior of the school
7 building, a sum not exceeding forty-eight hundred and
8 sixty dollars.

9 For painting the interior of the boarding hall, a sum
10 not exceeding thirteen hundred and sixty dollars.

11 For fire proof partitions in the attic of the school
12 building, a sum not exceeding twenty-four hundred and
13 sixty dollars.

14 For the renewal of the plumbing in Normal Hall, a
15 sum not exceeding thirty-two hundred and eight dollars.

16 And for hard pine floors for Normal Hall, a sum not
17 exceeding one thousand dollars.
