AN ACT DEFINING THE WORD "WHOLESALE" IN THE LAW RELATIVE
TO UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE AND BEDDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 270 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by Section 1 of Chapter 348 of the Acts of
3 1961, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the fol-
4 lowing definition: — "Wholesaler", a person who buys articles
5 of bedding or upholstered furniture from a manufacturer and
6 sells the same as such to a retailer. "Wholesaler" shall not
7 include persons who incidentally sell articles of bedding or up-
8 holstered furniture which have been incorporated into a prod-
9 uct which is primarily not considered bedding or upholstered
10 furniture, such as mobile homes, travel trailers, automobiles,
11 buses, trucks, boats, trains and similar products.
