By Mr. Perry of Monson, petition of John B. Perry relative to the sale of lottery tickets. Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOTTERY TICKETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 37 of Chapter 10 as most recently amended by section 2
2 of chapter 492 Acts of 1974 is hereby further amended by striking
3 the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:
4 The director may license any organization authorized to apply
5 for a license to conduct the game of beano under the provisions of
6 section thirty-eight to sell lottery tickets or shares, provided, that
7 the funds derived therefrom shall be used exclusively for
8 educational, charitable and religious purposes, and provided
9 further that such tickets shall be sold only on the premises of said
10 organization for which such license has been issued. The
11 commissioner shall sell lottery tickets to such licensed
12 organizations and any such licensed organization reselling such
13 tickets shall not be subject to prosecution for setting up and
14 promoting a lottery or any other crime incidental thereto or for
15 selling or having in its possession said lottery tickets.
