DECISION

A hearing was held to determine whether Majota, Inc., d.b.a. Crowley's Liquors violated Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (2 Counts).

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the investigators report dated March 30, 2007. The report states that on Friday, March 30, 2007 at approximately 9:00 p.m. A.B.C.C. investigators observed the business operation of Crowley's Liquors. They noticed two youthful looking males exit the store carrying two 30 packs of Keystone Light beer and two 40 ounce bottles of Bud Light beer. The young men were born on 01/29/1988 and 04/26/1988 (both age 19).

Administrative review of the file indicates this was the first violation by the licensee.

The Commission finds the licensee violated Chapter 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (2 Counts) and, therefore suspends the license for 8 days of which the 8 days will be held in abeyance for one year provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission regulations occur.
