### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE OF MATTRESSES AND ARTICLES OF UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section two hundred and seventy of chapter ninety-  
2 four of the General Laws, as amended by chapter one  
3 hundred and seventy-six of the acts of nineteen hun-  
4 dred and thirty-seven, is hereby amended by striking  
5 out, in the sixth sentence, the words "known in the  
6 trade as 'oily sweeps' or 'oily mill sweepings' is used  
7 in the filling of any article of bedding such material  
8 shall be named 'oily mill sweepings'" — and inserting  
9 in place thereof the words: — containing oil or grease  
10 in excess of one per cent is used in the filling of any  
11 article of bedding or articles of upholstered furniture  
12 the word "oil" shall be marked, — so as to read: —  
13 If what is known in the trade as "sweeps" or "sweep-  
14 ings" is used in the filling of any article of bedding,

15 such material shall be named "mill sweepings" on  
16 any tag required under this section and if material  
17 containing oil or grease in excess of one per cent is  
18 used in the filling of any article of bedding or articles  
19 of upholstered furniture the word "oil" shall be  
20 marked on any tag required under this section.
