AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ELIMINATE WATER POLLUTION IN MILL CREEK IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
2 department of public works is hereby authorized and directed
3 to take whatever action as may be necessary to eliminate water
4 pollution in the Mill creek in the city of Chelsea, said pollution
5 being dangerous to the health and welfare of the residents in the
6 area of said waterway; and said department is further author-
7 ized and directed to allocate sufficient funds to accomplish such
8 project.
