AN ACT PROVIDING HEALTH CARE FOR THE HOMELESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 117 of the General Laws, most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 758 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby amended by
- 3 striking out the third sentence of the first paragraph and substitut-
- 4 ing the following: —
- 5 Such assistance shall include payment for physician office visits,
- 6 basic dental care, drugs, laboratories, durable goods, eye care,
- 7 home health care, and inpatient, outpatient, and chronic care in
- 8 municipal, county, and private non-profit hospitals, provided that
- 9 the department shall require the use of such generic drugs as are
- 10 available and appropriate.
