The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF JOHN J. SAWTELLE AS A MEMBER IN SERVICE OF THE STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is immediately to authorize John J.
3 Sawtelle, an employee of the general court, to apply for re-
4 tirement under the state employees' retirement system, it is
5 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 John J. Sawtelle, an employee of the general court, is hereby
3 reinstated as a member in service of the state employees'
4 retirement system and shall be allowed to establish credit for
5 all of his service in the employ of the commonwealth; pro-
6 vided, that he pays into the annuity savings fund of said sys-
7 tem such amount as the state retirement board may determine
8 as being equal to that which he would have paid into said
9 fund had he been a member in service of said system during
10 all of the years of his service in the employ of the common-
11 wealth, with interest thereon. Upon compliance with the
12 aforesaid provision, said John J. Sawtelle may apply for re-
13 tirement under the state employees' retirement system.
