AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PERIODIC REPORT WHICH THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE IS REQUIRED TO FILE WITH THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2A of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (k), as most recently
3 amended by chapter 9 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following paragraph:—

5 (k) On the tenth day of October, January, April and July
6 make a report to the commission containing complete informa-
7 tion as to the division's activities during the preceding quarter,
8 including data on examinations, a complete list of non-competi-
9 tive appointments, if any, and a list of provisional appointments
10 made. Such report shall be a public record, and copies of it
11 shall be furnished to the governor and to the state library. On
12 or before October first of each year, the director shall also make
13 a report to the commission concerning the work of the division
14 for the previous fiscal year, including his recommendations, if
15 any, for the improvement of such work.
