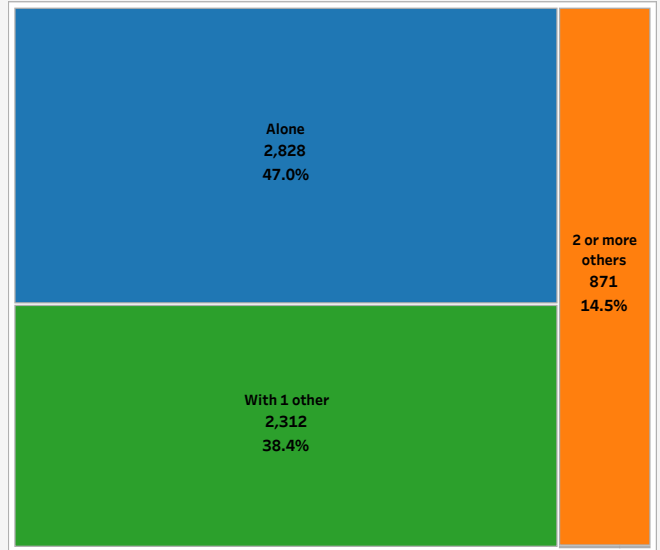

**The H4672 Act Addressing COVID-19 Data Collection and Disparities in Treatment**

**Population:** The population covered in this dashboard includes all incarcerated individuals in a Massachusetts Department of Correction (MA DOC) facility who occupy a bed on the date of the report. This population is defined as MA DOC Custody population. The count will exclude incarcerated individuals who are transferred outside of the MA DOC for a long term period of time, those who are transferred to a Remand, and those who are released to an outside hospital. For report purposes, these incarcerated individuals are reported as OUT-OF-DOC Transfers.

**Report Requirements**

The Department of Correction shall report the total number of residents per correctional facility, and the number of residents within each facility who are housed in a cell: (i) alone; (ii) with one (1) other; or (iii) with two (2) or more others; provided, however, that the Department of Correction and each sheriff provide this residential housing count information not less than weekly to the Department of Public Health.

The dashboard displays the number of incarcerated individuals in the Massachusetts Department of Correction housed in a cell: (i) alone; (ii) with one (1) other; or (iii) with two (2) or more others. The table provides counts and a percentage breakdown. The incarcerated individuals who are not currently active in a cell are termed as OUT-OF-DOC Transfer, and the table provides a separate count of these incarcerated individuals.
