AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH CERTAIN HIGHWAY FUNDS SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Whereas* The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose which is to extend forthwith the time within
3 which certain highway funds shall be available for expendi-
4 ture, therefor it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public con-
6 venience.

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 822 of the acts of 1963 is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "June" and
3 inserting in place thereof the word:— December.

1 SECTION 2. Section 5 of chapter 679 of the acts of 1965 is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 26, the word "June"
3 and inserting in place thereof the word:— December.
