By Mr. Bly of Saugus, petition of John W. Spencer that a certain physical condition resulting in total or partial disability to enforcing agents and inspectors of local health departments shall be presumed to have been suffered in line of duty under the accidental disability retirement law. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN PHYSICAL CONDITION OR DISEASE RESULTING IN TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN SUFFERED IN LINE OF DUTY, WITH REFERENCE TO THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by chapter 594 of the acts of 1951, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the word "police"
4 in line 10 the words: — or enforcing agents and in-
5 spectors of city and town public health departments.
