### AN ACT PLACING CABLE ANTENNA TELEVISION SERVICES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 12 of chapter 159 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 9 of chapter 563 of the acts of  
3 1964, is hereby further amended by inserting after subsection  
4 (d) the following subsection:—

5 (e) The department shall have general supervision and  
6 regulation of, and jurisdiction over cable antenna television  
7 services, and shall, after a hearing upon its own motion or  
8 upon complaint, determine just and reasonable rates and  
9 charges to be charged for the service to be rendered.
