RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN OVERPASS FROM BIRNIE AVENUE TO ROWLAND STREET OVER THE RAILROAD TRACKS AT SAID AREA IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of
3 the subject matter of current house document numbered 1759,
4 authorizing and directing the department of public works to
5 construct an overpass from Birnie avenue to Rowland street
6 over the railroad tracks at said area in the city of Springfield.
7 Said department shall report to the general court the results
8 of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
9 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said re-
10 ommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
11 the house of representatives on or before November thirtieth,
12 nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
