### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF BOSTON COLLEGE TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 123 of the acts of 1863 is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 3, as amended by section 3 of chapter 340 of  
3 the acts of 1908, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section: — *Section 3.* Said corporation may have a common  
5 seal, which they may alter or renew at their pleasure, and all  
6 deeds sealed with the seal of said corporation, and signed by  
7 their order, shall, when made in their corporate name, be con-  
8 sidered in law as the deeds of said corporation; and said cor-  
9 poration may sue and be sued in all actions, real, personal  
10 or mixed, and may prosecute the same to final judgment and  
11 execution by the name of the Trustees of Boston College; and  
12 said corporation shall be capable of taking and holding in fee  
13 simple or any less estate by gift, grant, bequest, devise, pur-  
14 chase or otherwise, any real or personal estate or interest  
15 therein within or without the commonwealth to an amount  
16 not exceeding seventy-five million dollars.
