By Mr. Kelly of Boston, petition of James H. Kelly that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to acquire from the city of Boston a certain parcel of land in the West Roxbury district to be used for playground and recreational facilities. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO ACQUIRE FROM THE CITY OF BOSTON A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND TO BE USED FOR PLAYGROUND AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to acquire from the city
3 of Boston, by purchase or gift, a certain parcel of land
4 located on Rosemary street in the West Roxbury district
5 of the city of Boston, being known as lots six, seven,
6 eight and nine, and containing fifteen thousand six
7 hundred and seventy-six square feet of land, for the
8 purpose of establishing and maintaining a playground
9 and recreational facilities thereon.

1 SECTION 2. For said purposes of this act the commis-
2 sion may expend such sums as may be appropriated
3 therefor.
