AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CHIEF LIBRARIAN OF THE TOWN OF EASTHAMPTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
- 2 law to the contrary, or of any rule or regulation of the board
- 3 of library commissioners, the present chief librarian of the
- 4 town of Easthampton shall be deemed to be a trained library
- 5 worker as required by clause (4) of section nineteen B of
- 6 chapter seventy-eight of the General Laws.
