An Act relative to Officers and Employees of the General Court as affected by the State Retirement Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section two of chapter thirty-two of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as most recently amended by section  
3 two of chapter two hundred and forty-eight of  
4 the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-eight,  
5 is hereby further amended by adding the follow-  
6 ing paragraph: —

7 (12) Nothing contained in this chapter shall  
8 be construed to require the retirement at any  
9 age therein specified of an officer or employee  
10 of the general court or to render unlawful service  
11 as such officer or employee after attaining to  
12 such an age.
