By Mrs. Metayer of Braintree, petition of Elizabeth N. Metayer that the Attorney-General be authorized to sue on behalf of the Commonwealth for non-payment of the excise on motor vehicles. Taxation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO SUE ON BEHALF OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR NONPAYMENT OF THE EXCISE ON MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2A of chapter 60A of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 1973, is hereby further  
3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 If the foregoing provisions of this section have been complied  
5 with, and the excise assessed under this chapter remains unpaid,  
6 the attorney general shall sue on behalf on the commonwealth in  
7 order to collect such excise. Funds collected by the attorney gen-  
8 eral as a result of such legal action shall be credited to the city or  
9 town in which such excise is assessed in order to reduce any  
10 outstanding obligation due the commonwealth from such city or  
11 town.
