AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE TO ADMINISTRATORS AND EXECUTORS OF THE FILING OF CLAIMS AGAINST AN ESTATE BY CREDITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The first paragraph of section 9 of chapter 197 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 15 of chapter 515 of the acts of 1975, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "probate", in line 17, the words: — and a notice of such filing has been mailed by certified mail to the executor or administrator within seven days of such filing.
