#### Decision

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether the licensee Greyhound Package Store Inc violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) permitting an illegality on the licensed premises to wit: Ch. 138, §34 sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age.

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the investigator's report and the Commission finds said facts contained therein. This violation was found pursuant to a sting operation conducted by the ABCC and MADD. Investigators testified that pursuant to a sting operation, the operative a 17 year old, purchased a 22 oz. Budweiser Beer in the amount of \$1.75. The operative was not asked for identification by the clerk.

The licensee stated he has had only one prior violation in 25 years of ownership. He also has participated with MADD in the past, as well as the "Cops in Shops" program.

The Commission finds the licensee in violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises to wit: Ch. 138, §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. The Commission herein suspends the license for a period of 5 days.
