## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Four.

Resolve providing for an Investigation as to Relocating Certain Elevated Structures in Cambridge Street in the City of Boston in connection with the Widening of said Street.

1 *Resolved*, That the transit department of the city of  
2 Boston be directed to investigate and determine, in  
3 connection with the proposed improvements authorized  
4 by chapter four hundred and eighty-nine of the acts of  
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, the most available  
6 and advantageous location, either within the limits of  
7 the sidewalks or on private property, of the exit and  
8 entrance to the East Boston tunnel extension located in  
9 Cambridge street at or near North and South Russell  
10 streets, and report the new location so determined and  
11 the cost of removing such structures to the new location  
12 determined as aforesaid, together with the cost involved  
13 in the acquisition of any land necessary to carry out  
14 such removal. Said report, with recommendations, if  
15 any, shall be filed with the general court, on or before  
16 December fifteenth in the current year.
